I have undergone some tests this week that have shown no masses or growths anywhere. That is good news for which we praise God. I have an appointment with a radiation oncologist on Dec 28th to discuss my status and options. I won't have any idea of the impact on our schedule until after that appointment. Meanwhile, we are pressing on with several projects, including the seminar.

Thank you for praying for us. We can tell that God's faithful people have been lifting us up to Throne of Grace.
