After visiting with my doctor last week, he told me that I am still cancer free but that he still wants to monitor my blood work every three months for a while. Things are slowing down quite a bit with regard to my Mother's Living Trust. As Trustee, I have been very busy administering the Trust. The only thing remaining is the sale of her little house in Arkansas. Please pray with us that God will send a buyer soon so that I can bring the Trust to a close. I really didn't know how much time would be involved as Successor Trustee – but God did. He has allowed me to continue our ministry, howbeit at a slower pace, while administering the Trust.

I was able to help point several pastors and church folk in the right direction concerning air evacuation coverage for their trips overseas on short term mission trips. Negotiations are still ongoing for coverage for our missionary families through a company in New England. So far, it looks very good for better coverage at less cost. Please pray for wisdom in negotiations.

Given recent kidnappings of faith based workers overseas and the increase in violence and scrutiny directed toward all westerners – especially those involved in Christian ministry – I have stepped up the development of the preparedness seminar for missionaries, sending pastors, and supporting church members. Please pray with me that we can get started with these seminars later this year and that they will greatly benefit our missionary effort.

Recently, while visiting a church, I had opportunity to ask one of the men of the church how he and the Lord were getting along. He just stared at me and tried to say something, anything, but could not. After sputtering for a minute, I talked with him and told him the Lord hasn't moved; He is right where He has always been. I asked this man if he didn't think it would be a good idea to get better acquainted with our Lord. He agreed. When focus returns to God and His work in these last days, He will accomplish more in missions for His glory around the world.

It is incumbent upon us to prepare as best we can to be available to Him for His plan and purpose in our lives. May we ever be aware of our vocation and calling in Christ Jesus and our stewardship of that which He has entrusted to us.

We are looking forward to fellowshiping with you all soon and reporting on how God has been at work in the ministry. If you have any questions about the seminar training, please contact me.
