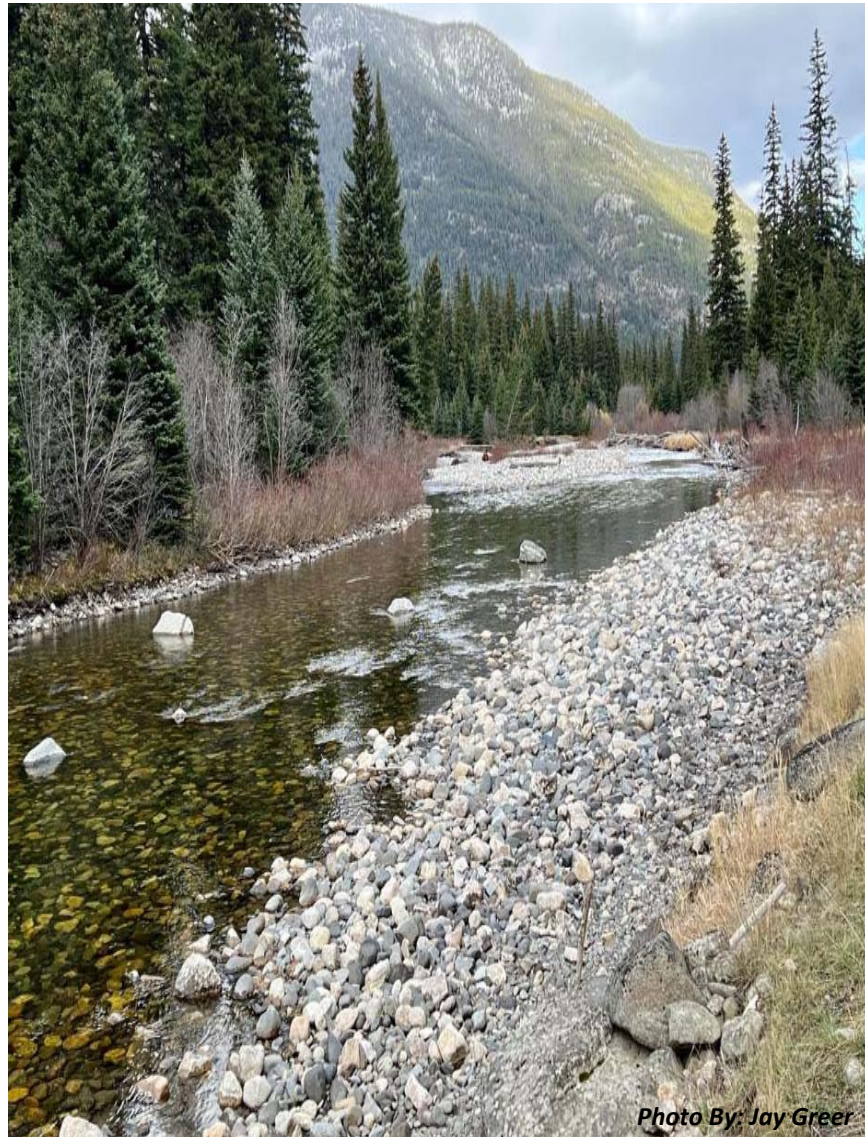

# Abstracts in Focus

## SEE THE NEW EVO PUMP

This **technical** presentation on Wednesday in Hot Topics at 1:50 pm will provide a case study of a new technology for wastewater treatment processes. The application of an EVO (electric) pump for transfer of wastewater to different process tanks. In addition, the EVO pump is an excellent pump for sludges and your main pump for filter presses and other filtration technologies. Discussion will focus on challenges and this new technology to remove pollutants in wastewater treatment while achieving cost savings and environmental benefits. You will learn that one of the main benefits of this new pump is the ability to fully deadhead should a system become clogged or if your system simply needs to deadhead for certain applications. Yes, this electric pump can be deadheaded just like an air operated pump can. *The pump is being demonstrated at the front entrance under the portico. Please feel free to visit the demo during WITtec for a closer look at this new technology.*

*Nick Frame has been at ARO in his Technical Support Role for just shy of 7 years. In this role, he supports all of ARO's product lines, including air operated diaphragm pumps, electric process pumps, FRL's and cylinders.*
