A native of Saint John, New Brunswick, baritone Christopher Lane made his professional operatic debut with Opera New Brunswick in *Carmen*. As a soloist, he has appeared with Orchestra London and Musical Theatre Productions in London.

Mr. Lane is Director of Music and Administration at Saint David's United Church and is in demand as a vocal teacher, coach, adjudicator and clinician. A graduate of Western University, he is director of the Carleton Choristers, Harbour View Choral Ensembles, and Saint John Rotary Boys Choir. In 2012 he was named Music Director of the Kennebecasis Valley Players. Since 2002, he has been an active member of the Juno-nominated Canadian Chamber Choir.

From 2006-2010, he was the Executive Director of Opera New Brunswick. He currently serves as Treasurer for the New Brunswick Federation of Music Festivals, the Federation of Canadian Music Festivals, the Canadian Chamber Choir, and the New Brunswick Competitive Festival of Music, and is a member of the Board of Directors of the New Brunswick Choral Federation.

In 2008, he was named one of New Brunswick's 21 Leaders for the 21st Century.
