

Who's Russell?




Russell Brooks is the author of *Pandora's Succession*, *Unsavoury Delicacies*, *Chill Run* and *The Demeter Code*.


Pandora's Succession


These are three short stories of suspense with the common theme of fine dining and revenge. And Ridley Fox makes an appearance.



Young Montrealer set to release third spy novel

As a teenager in the mid 1990s, Russell Brooks was a budding Olympic sprinter laden with hope and potential. He also had a strong appetite for thrillers, espionage and sci-fi movies.


By 2007, his dream of becoming one of the fastest men in the world had ran its course, but not before Brooks completed a partial athletic scholarship at the University of Indiana, represented Canada and left his mark as one of Quebec's top sprinters.

His withdrawal from athletics opened a way for him to explore his other passion and within a year he published Pandora's Succession, a harrowing action-packed thriller filled with the threat of bio terrorism and the heroics of Ridley Fox, a CIA operative who makes his way in Brooks' subsequent books.

The debut novel immediately announced Brooks arrival in the fast-paced world of the thriller genre and hinted at comparisons to luminaries such as Robert Ludlum and Michael Crichton.

This summer, the Montrealer

of Barbadian heritage is about to release The Demeter Code, his third full-length thriller, which will again take readers on a fast-paced ride around the world of

embassy bombings, CIA operatives, the deadly shenanigans of multinational corporations and the threat of terror attacks on the USA homeland.

Brooks, who holds a Biology degree from University of Indiana, says the work is a manifestation of his enduring fascination with science and action-packed movies.

"I'm a dedicated follower of the CIA, FBI and NSA, and a

great deal of the material I (garner) sometimes find its way into my books," he says. "Also, a lot of present-day issues are weaved into the stories, so readers can expect to find an issue like identity theft as a recurring theme in my books."

Brooks says the writing bug has been with him since the age of 14, but it lay dormant while he explored his passion as a sprinter.

Along the way he rose to the top of the heap of Quebec sprinters. He represented Canada at the World University Games in Spain in 1999, and at the Canadian Championships in Winnipeg held his own against Canadian sprint legends, Donovan Bailey and Bruny Surin.

Brooks penned two other books, Unsavory Delicacies, a collection of short stories and Chill Run, described by a reader as a "A real thriller running with humor and chills."

On July 19, Montrealers can experience the thrill of trying to crack the Code when Brooks launches the Demeter Code with a reading at Monty's Hair Salon, 4055 St. Catherine Street W, Suite 122.
