Entry Fee - \$25.00 per head Entry Deadline – March 10, 2020

Eligibility

- General rules for the Junior Livestock Show of Spokane apply.
- Heifer must have been born on or after Sept. 1, 2018 to be eligible.
- Brand certificates are required on all heifers along with proof of ownership by March of current year. These documents are to be presented at weigh-in.
- All heifers coming from out of state must have a health certificate issued prior to transporting.
- Entry fee is non-refundable
- Each exhibitor will be allowed to enter up to 2 heifers.

Classes

- Heifers will show by age, therefore birthdate <u>MUST</u> be submitted on entry form.
- Heifers will be classed by age, into as equal groups as possible by show officials.
- First and second place winners in each class will be eligible for Championship competition.
- 4-H and FFA will show separately, unless numbers warrant otherwise.
- Fitting & Showing of heifers: See rule #10 pg.10 of Premium Book.

Arrival and Release Times

- Stalls will be available anytime after 4:00 PM Tuesday, May 5, 2020, following weigh-in.
- Heifers must be weighed and checked into the show grounds no later than 7:00 PM Tuesday, May 5, 2020.
- Heifers will be released after 5:00 PM Friday, May 8, 2020. Exhibitor must check out with barn superintendent before leaving the fairgrounds.

Awards

- Premiums will be paid to all participants.
- Some breed awards are available. Refer to Premium Book.
