

**JUNIOR LIVESTOCK SHOW OF SPOKANE**  
**JACKPOT PROSPECT STEER SHOW**

Location: Spokane County Fair & Expo Center – Spokane, WA  
Thursday May 3, 2018

**Entry Fee - \$40.00 per head**

**Entry Deadline – April 10, 2018**

**Eligibility**

- General rules for the Junior Livestock Show of Spokane apply.
- Brand certificates are required on all steers along with proof of ownership by March of the current year. These documents are to be presented at weigh-in.
- All steers coming from out of state must have a health certificate issued prior to transporting. See rule #21 pg.6 of Premium Book.
- Only steers NOT showing in the market steer show are eligible.
- On the entry form, exhibitors must state which fair the steer is going to and the form must be signed by the exhibitor and FFA advisor, 4-H Leader, Extension Agent, or parent/legal guardian.
- Entry fee is non-refundable.

**Classes**

- Classes will be divided by weight, into as equal groups as possible by show officials.
- All first and second place purple ribbon prospect steers will return for Championship competition.
- 4-H and FFA will show separately.
- Fitting & Showing of prospect steers: See rule #10 pg.10 of Premium Book.

**Arrival and Release Times**

- Stalls will be available anytime after 4:00 PM Tuesday, May 1, 2018, following weigh-in.
- Steers must be weighed and checked into the show grounds no later than 7:00 PM Tuesday, May 1, 2018.
- Steers will be weighed between 4 – 7:00 PM Tuesday, May 1, 2018.
- Steers will be released after 5:00 PM Friday, May 4, 2018.

**Awards**

- Premiums will be paid to all participants.
- \$25.00 of entry fee will go toward Jackpot payout.
- Jackpot dollars will be paid to at least 5 steers in each division, 4-H and FFA; the amount of sponsorship dollars received will determine payout.

**Special Awards**

- Other awards for prospect steers will be announced at the Show.
