To qualify for the Junior Livestock Show of Spokane Student Ambassador Program, you must be a high school junior or equivalent.

1. With at least a 3.0 GPA (Please enclose a copy of your school transcript).
2. You must have participated in the Junior Livestock Show of Spokane for a minimum of 2 years.
3. Submit at least two but not more than four letters of recommendations from 4-H leaders, FFA Advisors, school counselor or teachers, a coach, etc.

The above listed items will be submitted with your application. You will be scheduled for a personal interview on Tuesday of the show as part of the application process also. Applications must be submitted to the Junior Livestock Show Office no later than April 10th. Please read this application carefully as only COMPLETE applications will be considered.

4. There will be 2 Ambassadors chosen yearly. They will serve for 2 shows.
 - a. Ambassadors duties during show will be to take an active roll in the Opening Ceremonies, will work with Show Manager, Ambassador Coordinator, and barn superintendents. Some duties will be to collect championship information for all contests being held during the show for the show office, and any other tasks that may be asked of you. Also take photographs throughout the show.
 - b. Newly chosen Ambassadors will also be asked to promote the Junior Livestock Show throughout the year at least 3 community, local, or state events.

Ambassadors will receive a Jr. Show Jacket and will also be eligible for a scholarship when attending college following the completion of your 2nd Jr. Show obligations.
