Further we do request HHJ Mark Raeside's original hand written notes 'wet ink' used to form his decision in the BOS v Michaels Case 4PA41550.

This request is backed by Affidavits submitted to the court and witnessed by Canon LAWYER Reverend C Murtagh, declaring that Paul Michaels am born in Leeds on the 24th October 1966 and Charlotte Sarah Michaels born in Epsom on 27th August 1976, are real live people requesting a fair and Just hearing by the United Kingdom Justice system, which considers and includes all the facts submitted to the court and sworn under Oath as the true facts.

As per the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) ruling in the Percival Matter, now a precedent, and Ruling of the United Kingdom Supreme Court of Justice, the Ministry of Justice has an obligation to hand over to us, and we are entitled to see the original judges notes in 'wet ink' and use these notes to understand how the decision that we are disagreeing with, was made.
