We attach a link to our case file, which regrettably we advise has now been posted online. We are in the process of posting the court of appeal, Supreme court files which will be linked to our original case, along with emails to Lloyds Bank of Scotland, TMB, RBC, courts, police and Fraud Squad etc.

The Information Commissioners Office has as of the 21 December 2017, charged the Ministry of Justice with failing to comply with regulation, and supply information requested by us and others under the Official Data Protection Act 1998. We have requested ALL judges and clerks hand written notes (wet ink) which they have declined to give us stating, "HHJ Mark Raeside does not considered his notes as Data." The ICO has previously ruled on this specific point that they are. This refusal to supply the notes as well as other information by the MOJ and ANY data at all requested under our LLOYDS BOS TMB SAR requests, is 'Concealment' which is Fraud, and reclassifies any civil matter as a 'Criminal' and brings it into the criminal courts. We will now get the opportunity to have our case heard in a Crown Court with a jury who will scrutinise ALL participants and events in this illegal and fraudulent process.

Under the Canadian 'Privacy Act' we are currently in the process of requesting our data from the Royal Bank of Canada and Others.

Please with immediate effect request that any charges and information relating to us and our alleged loans are deleted from the Land Registry. Further that all Credit Reference Agency files pertains to the Lloyds group, are formally deleted or marked 'Satisfactorily Settled'. On Friday 5 January, our legal conveyancer will check that this has been done.
