C.U.R.E is honored to announce that this year's annual commemoration of World AIDS Day will take place on Friday, November 30, 2018 at the prestigious **George W. Bush Presidential Center in Dallas, TX**. For over 10 years, C.U.R.E has been addressing the stigma associated with HIV/AIDS by working to unite communities and inspire social change.

This event presents an occasion to commemorate this day of remembrance and mark the 37th year since the Center for Disease Control discovered the presence of the HIV virus in the United States. Since then, this virus has reshaped our world and the lives of people who have been infected by it including families, friends, and communities.

"Ending AIDS Together . . . ", this year's theme, reminds us that over the last 37 years, this pandemic has impacted all people regardless of race, creed or color. And **TOGETHER** we can end this pandemic through our continued efforts to reduce stigma, ensure access, increase resources and promote involvement.

The entrance to the Bush Presidential Center will provide an impressive backdrop for portions of the acclaimed AIDS Memorial Quilt that will be showcased at this event. One the highlights of this year's event is our Keynote Speaker, **Robert Suttle, Assistant Director of the Sero Project** in Milford, Pennsylvania. Robert, an African-American gay male living with HIV, was released from a Louisiana prison in January, 2011, after accepting a plea bargain and serving six months for a conviction under Louisiana's so-called "Intentional Exposure to AIDS Virus" statute.

Continuing our tradition of recognizing organizations and individuals, C.U.R.E. will present our “Open Heart” Awards and shine the spotlight on those who have made a significant contribution to the importance of HIV/AIDS care, prevention and education.

The reception begins at 5:30 PM with the program starting at 7:00 PM. Attendance at this event provides a unique opportunity to learn, to remember, to reflect, and to hope.
