

Community Chinese IV

Community Chinese Level IV allows students who successfully completed Community Chinese III at Linguate Academy, or those who have a similar level of Chinese, can use Chinese to serve their demands in their personal lives and studies, and are able to complete most of the communicative tasks they experience during a visit to China. Students who complete this level may want to consider taking the YCT-4.*

YCT Testing

YCT is an international standardized Chinese language test which is directed at examining non-native primary and secondary school students' ability to apply Chinese language in their studies and daily lives.

It consists of two independent parts: written test and oral test. The written test is made up of four levels from YCT Level 1 to YCT Level 4.

The oral test includes YCT-Speaking Basic and YCT-Speaking Intermediate, and the test taker's on-site performance will be recorded.

The YCT is for non-native, primary and secondary school students up to age 15.

Testing Purpose

The YCT is intended for students whose mother tongue is not Chinese. The results of the test can serve various purposes:

- A method for Chinese language learners to assess and improve their proficiency in Chinese.
- A reference for Chinese language training in schools.
- A method for Chinese language training institutions to evaluate training results.
- A benchmark for students who want to participate in the HSK test.

Registering for the YCT Test

Parents that would like to have their students register for any of the YCT paper based or online test administered by the Confucius Institute at Valparaiso University must notify Linguage Academy staff 3 months prior to the testing date.

Fees

Fees and registration for the YCT are **NON-REFUNDABLE**. If any registration is cancelled more than 48 hours in advance of the test date, the registration and fees will be applied to a future test date within one calendar year. Any registrations cancelled after the 48-hour deadline will not be rescheduled and all fees forfeited.
