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WATER WELL AGREEMENT AND EASEMENT

On this 5^{++} day of A_{pri} , 1977, JACK SIRUCEK and PHYLLIS J. SIRUCEK, hereafter referred to as Grantors, do grant to GREGORY R. BAIN and DEBRA L. BAIN, husband and wife, hereafter referred to as Grantees, the following easements:

1. For the purpose of securing water for the benefit of Parcel 4A according to Certificate of Survey No. 3204, records of Plathead County, Montana, said Parcel resting in the Northeast Quarter of Section 19, Range 29 West, Township 21 North, M.P.M., Flathead County, Montana, the Grantors do grant to the Grantees, their heirs, successors and assigns, an easement for acquisition of water and a right to use water coming from that certain well more particularly described below and located in Parcel 4B of that same Township, Section and Range and as identified on that same survey, being the remainder resulting from that survey. Said easement shall be appurtenant to Parcel 4A as above described.

2. For the purposes and use of a common garage and well house the Grantors do grant to the Grantees an easement commencing at the West corner of the boundary line between Parcel 4A and Parcel 4B above described; extending in a northerly direction a distance of approximately 12 feet; then extending in an easterly direction a distance of approximately 24 feet; then extending in a southerly direction a distance of approximately 12 feet to the said boundary line. This grant shall also be made appurtenant to Parcel 4A and is granted in consideration and agreement stated below.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND STATED, that the Grantees, in consideration of the grant by the Grantors above stated and the agreement entered into below, do hereby grant to the above-stated Grantors an easement for garage purposes across Parcel 4A above described and appurtenant to Parcel 4B. Said easement shall commence at the West corner line of the boundary between Parcels 4A and 4B above described and extend southward a distance of approximately 12 feet and thence eastward a distance of approximately 24 feet; thence northward a distance of approximately 12 feet to that boundary line above described.

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IT IS EXPRESSLY UNDERSTOOD, that in all easements granted hereby and in all rights granted hereby the parties so granting, reserve the right to use said easement for their own benefit. IT IS FURTHER AGREED between the Grantors and Grantees that that certain well located in Parcel 4B above-described and recorded controls aff to the first fir

shall be equal for each parcel. The parties hereto agree that they are mutually and equally responsible for the maintenance and costs thereof of said well and piping system and all costs accruing for the above-stated well shall be divided equally between the two parties.

In addition, that certain garage subject to the above-stated easements is to be deemed the property of the parties hereto with the above-stated Grantors having an undivided one-half interest therein and the above-stated Grantees having an undivided one-half interest therein.
