Music Competition Rules

A. Categories

Professional (Music schools/Music Department of universities)

- Children: Solo (6-11 years old, born in 2009-2014)
- Junior: Solo (12-17 years old, born in 2003-2008)
- Youth: Solo (18 years old or older, born before 2002)
- Ensemble / Chorus
- Composition

Non-professional

- Children: Solo (6-11 years old, born in 2009-2014)
- Junior: Solo (12-17 years old, born in 2003-2008)
- Youth: Solo (18 years old or older, born before 2002)
- Ensemble / Chorus

B. Rules for Each Section

Vocal Competition

- Chinese folk songs and bel canto.
- Repertoire: Free choice.
- Duration: Within 10 minutes.
- Juries can stop the performance if the competitor exceeds the allotted time.
- All pieces should be singing according to the original text.
- If an accompaniment is needed, please inform the Organizing Committee in advance and submit relevant materials.
- Awards: Gold, Silver, Bronze and Excellence Awards will be presented in proportion; Excellent Guide Teacher Award will be presented.



Instrumental Competition

- Chinese traditional music and western music.
- Repertoire: Free choice.
- Duration: Within 10 minutes.
- Juries can stop the performance if the competitor exceeds the allotted time.
- If an accompaniment is needed, please inform the organizing committee in advance and submit relevant materials.
- Awards: Gold, Silver, Bronze and Excellence Awards will be presented in proportion; Excellent Guide Teacher Award will be presented.

Composition

- This composing competition is for young composers under the age of 35.
- Submit a piece that has not been publicly performed and published.
- The submitted composition must be written for an ensemble of 2 or up to 9 musicians, and it must include both Chinese and Western Instruments.
- Instrumentation: Pipa, Guzheng, Erhu, Chinese percussion instruments; Flute, Violin, Cello, Double Bass, Piano, Trumpet, Accordion.
- Duration should go between 8-12 minutes.
- Submission Deadline: 1st Dec 2019.
- The competition committee sill informs the winners by email, and will also make a public announcement at www.cuimf.com by the middle of December, 2019. The selected composers must submit parts (PDF) no later than 20th December 2019.
- The winning music works will premiere at the China-UK International Music Festival by musicians from the Royal Academy of Music and Central Conservatory of Music and will be recommended to the Deal Music and Arts and Oxford Festival of the Arts in the UK. Winners will have the opportunity to attend the premiere in the UK, and those who are not present will be considered abstained.



- Competitors are required to send the following materials in PDF to info@cuimf.com by 1st December 2019:
 - a) Biography (including full name, address, phone number, email address) and a personal photo
 - b) Program notes
 - c) An e-copy of your National ID card and passport information page.
 - d) An e-copy of the audio and full score of the work (only accept PDF documents)
 - e) Bio, program notes, title and performance explanations must be in both Chinese and English.
- Awards:
 - 1 First prize, £1000 (gross)
 - 1 Second prize, £800 (gross)
 - 2 Third prize, £500 (gross)
- Submission fee is not required.

C. Resources of the Organizing Committee

- 1. The Organizing Committee can provide instruments such as zither, piano for free
- 2. The Organizing Committee may provide a piano accompanist for participants and arrange rehearsal time. A fee will be charged. More information please contact info@cuimf.com.
- 3. Gold winners will be recommended to the Deal Music and Arts and Oxford Festival of the Arts in the UK, and the organizers will be responsible for some travel expenses.
