



We will combine the enrollment fees with the proceeds from the sale of club back numbers to make the Jackpot amount for the year end award! The money will be split between the qualified Yearling Champion (60%) and Reserve Champion (40%). All club points are tallied just as in all other year end award eligible classes (See points calculation chart below). Even though you are competing in the yearling Challenge you can still qualify for VSPO year end awards in addition to the challenge.

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1) Owner and Exhibitor must be a current 2019 member of VSPO.
- 2) Fill out the Yearling Challenge Enrollment Form and pay the \$25 Enrollment fee
- 3) Points will only accumulate from the date that both qualifications #1 and #2 are met.
- 4) A yearling <u>MUST</u> compete in <u>ALL THREE YEARLING</u> classes offered to at <u>least</u> 6 Judges at VSPO shows during 2019 show year (January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019).

The 3 Classes Required Are: (Halter, Longeline, In-Hand Trail)

- 1. <u>All Sexes/All Types Yearling Challenge Halter Class</u> (This will be separately judged from the association halter classes.
- 2. <u>Yearling Longeline</u>- You can participate in either or both **OPEN** APHA/PtHA Yearling Longeline classes. The Yearling Challenge scores will be collected from both associations classes and your highest scoring run will count toward your overall placing. The number of horses used for the calculation of points at that show will be based on the total number of Yearling Challenge Enrolled horses in that <u>class</u> on that day. (\*\*Due to APHA rules our March show will not have yearling longeline, but we will be offering <u>PtHA Yearling Longeline</u>.)
- 3. <u>Yearling In-Hand Trail</u>- You can participate in either or both **OPEN** APHA/PtHA Yearling In-Hand Trail classes. The Yearling Challenge scores will be collected from both associations classes and your highest scoring run will count toward your overall placing. The number of horses used for the calculation of points at that show will be based on the total number of Yearling Challenge Enrolled horses in that <u>class</u> on that day.
