- 2. Ensure all your pieces are clearly marked with your details if leaving at class.
- Pieces left and not touched in 2mths will be removed and stored for 1 month. If not collected will be given away or on sold.
- 4. Please ask staff if class paints need replacing.
- 5. Always wash Brushes in clean water and using a little dish drops or brush cleaner and rinse well.
- 6. Class brushes, please check with staff if unsure which brushes are used for the paint your using as not to contaminate your piece.
- 7. Allow at least two weeks for firing as we will only fire if we have a full kiln.
- 8. Paint and tool orders may take a month to supply.
