A Talk By Dr. E.C. Krupp

California cultures' astronomical observations structured time and space. Join us as Dr. Krupp discusses celestial symbolism and its connection to the stories and ceremonies that framed people's lives. Evidence for astronomy in indigenous California is evident from ethnography and rock art sites, where events in light-and-shadow may confirm part of the meaning the sky once had. With an emphasis on Chumash sites and traditions, the program will also include examples from other tribal territories.
