Welcome to the *Black Box Performance Project - Summer Intensive!* We are VERY excited to work on Disney's The Lion King Jr. with your children this summer! This letter should give you much needed information regarding rehearsal schedule, program information, dates and times etc. Please know how honored we are to work with each and every student to help them learn the process of creating characters within the confines of a dramatic play or musical.

The **audition** date is Saturday, June 29th from 9:00AM-12:00PM at the Southampton Cultural Center (SCC - 25 Pond Lane Southampton, NY 11968). The audition process will be first come first serve. Once we have heard your child sing and read script excerpts from the musical they are free to leave. Please note that ALL children will receive a role, there are no cuts for this show. The audition song will be determined within the next few weeks and you will receive a link to a soundcloud account with which they can practice the chosen song before the audition date.

Our rehearsal schedule will be Monday through Friday 9:00AM-12:30PM at the Southampton Cultural Center. Our rehearsals will begin Monday July 1st. There will be NO rehearsals July 4th and 5th due to the holiday.

The performance dates are July 19th at 7PM; July 20th at 3PM and at 7PM. Student arrival call time for the show days will be 4PM on Friday July 19th (no morning rehearsal) and 12:00PM on Saturday July 20th. Dinner will be provided on both show days for the student actors.

Please make every effort to have your child attend each rehearsal for the overall success of our show, and for the program as a whole. Each and every day they will be learning valuable information which will only benefit their future.

Tuition fee for this workshop is \$700 and includes the following:

- Cast t-shirts to be worn for performances and to be kept as souvenirs
- African drumming lesson taught by an area percussion professional
- African dance lesson taught by an expert dance professional
- Outside makeup artist to provide expert makeup for the performances
- 3 complimentary tickets for each actor to be used all at once or spread out as desired.

- Video of the performance
- Access to a professional photo album, where pictures can be purchased
- Daily snacks
- 140 character shout out for each actor to be placed in the program
- 2 professional directors and 1 assistant working with the students daily
- Professional lighting design
- Professional sound design (microphones for the majority of the cast)
- Professional poster signed by the cast members
