### VENDOR APPLICATION <u>INSTRUCTIONS</u> RHINEBECK JUNE 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018 http://therhinebeckmeet.org/vending.html

The following information is provided to assist you in completing the application. <u>Please read the following</u> <u>instructions</u>. If the application is not complete, it may delay processing (and another vendor may get the space you want). If you need assistance or have any questions, you may contact the Vending Committee at 845-418-2010 or e-mail us at vendors@therhinebeckmeet.org.

<u>General</u>: All standard outdoor spaces have a minimum of 500 square feet. Some spaces back up against fences, but many have unallocated easement space behind them. The dimensions and specific details for each space are available on the web site (or phone).

- 1. A Vending Space map is available on the website; you may use it to identify the specific spaces or area you are requesting.
- 2. You MUST supply proof of current AMCA membership for yourself and for anyone else for whom you seek a Vendor's Vehicle Pass: According to the Rules for Vendors, only one Vehicle Pass will be issued per spot and a maximum of two Vendor's Tickets per vehicle will be issued. These Passes/Tickets may only be given to individuals listed with your application that you certify will be working on your behalf in your spots.
- 3. Include your Company name, if applicable.
- 4. Please provide a basic description of your intended merchandise (see Rules for restrictions on merchandise).
- 5. You must provide a complete mailing address so we can send you your registration package and related documents.
- 6. If you have an e-mail address, please provide that as well, since it may be faster and cheaper to communicate with you as needed.
- 7. Please let us know what type of vehicles you're bringing and how long they are. Some spots are not good for big rigs, while others are fine.
- 8. You must provide at least one telephone number so we can contact you with any questions.
- 9. Each Standard Space will be at least 500 sq. ft. Some may be slightly larger due to obstacles or terrain.
- 10. Due to unique obstacles and terrain in some areas of the Fairgrounds, as well as specific Vendor requests, some spaces may only be reserved as a single contiguous block of spaces.
- 11. There are over 120 indoor 10'x10' spots marked off inside Buildings C and D. These spots can be combined to create a larger space for Vendors requiring space inside. These spots are \$20 each. Inside vending spots entitle vendor to 1 wristband for an area up to 500 sq. ft. and 2 wristbands for spots greater than 500 sq. ft.
- 12. There are eight covered "Pavilion" Spaces next to Building E. These Spaces have electricity, lighting, and water. These are \$65 each.
- 13. You can pay for advertising in the official program with your application, but it is best to coordinate and pay for advertising by contacting the Advertising Committee at: advertising@therhinebeckmeet.org.
- 14. If you are not an AMCA member or you need to join or renew your membership before the Meet, you may do so <u>instantly</u> online at <u>https://secure.cornerstonereg.com/amca/newmember.asp</u> (from there, you can also download, print, and complete an application). If joining online, please include with your Vending Application a printout of your confirmation e-mail (it will contain your AMCA number).
- 15. Please do not mail cash.
- 16. If you would like mail or e-mail confirmation that your application has been processed, please include e-mail address or a self-addressed and stamped return envelope.
- 17. <u>Important Deadline May 1, 2018</u>: Deadline for receipt of 2018 Vendors registration and payment to get assigned the same spaces as 2017. You may specify your requested spot <u>using Field Color AND Spot numbers</u>. All requests are first-come/first-serve. HOWEVER, if you were a Vendor in 2017, we will "pencil in" your same space in for 2018 but will release it after the deadline indicated. Please try to register as early as possible; we will try our best to contact you prior to releasing vending spots.



# **AGREEMENT RULES FOR VENDORS** RHINEBECK JUNE 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018

I understand that the flea market is a privilege extended to members of the Antique Motorcycle Club of America (National AMCA) to sell merchandise specifically related to antique motorcycles. I understand that all vendors must be paid (current) members of the National AMCA. Merchandise offered for sale is restricted to antique motorcycles, motorcycle parts, literature, accessories, and specifically related items. Displays are to be neatly arranged on tables or ground cloths. I understand that the Northeast Coalition of Chapters and its agents reserve the right to restrict participants and spectators to acceptable behavior during all activities.

#### **BEHAVIOR: I AGREE TO:**

- Not engage in any business transactions outside the time periods the meet is open to the public.

- Keep my displays neat and clean.
  Conduct myself in a business-like manner.
  Leave the grounds clean after use and remove everything I came with.
- Not engage in profanity or playing of loud music.
  Park a maximum of one (1) vehicle per vending space.
- Not bring pets onto the fairgrounds.
- Comply with any and all tax collection rules.

- Not exceed 10 MPH in operation of any vehicle
- Not sell/display motorcycles or parts newer than 1982.
- Not sell/display clothing with questionable wording or pictures, guns, knives, drugs or paraphernalia related to same, novelties, nor alcoholic beverages.
- Not sell any meet-related clothing or accessories.
- Not allow unlicensed drivers and/or drivers under 16 to • operate motorized vehicles on the premises.
- Not operate any golf carts or all-terrain vehicles.

**LIABILITY:** In consideration for the rights to participate, vendor (by execution of the application form) releases and discharges The Big Sandbar and Hudson Valley Chapters, the Dutchess County Fairgrounds, National AMCA, their officers, agents, directors, employees, workers, volunteers, representatives of and members at large from any and all known and unknown damages, injuries, losses, judgments, and claims from any cause whatsoever that may be suffered by any entrant, spectator passenger or his or her property. For value hereby received (i.e., my rights to use the facilities provided to sell my wares), I hereby agree and affirm that I am familiar with all the sales tax rules and regulations pertaining to the area and that if any tax money from my transactions is due to any state, city or other taxing authority, I will collect same, file all reports necessary and save the Big Sandbar and Hudson Valley Chapters and National AMCA, Inc. harm from any and all other liabilities which may incur to the club from any of my transactions, be it tax or any other liability arising out of my transactions.

**VENDING VEHICLES, TICKETS, & SPOT RIGHTS:** I understand (A) I will be provided with a Vending Vehicle Pass that I must display in the window of any vehicle of mine operated in the Vending Areas, that only one Vehicle Pass may be issued per spot, and that each Vehicle Pass shall require AMCA membership; and (B) that Vending Vehicle Passes will only be issued to registered vendors and that other parking for vendors is available in the Main Lot or, if camping, in the Tent Camping or RV Hookup Areas; and (C) that it is my obligation to request all Vehicle Passes with my Vendor Application; and (D) that a maximum of two Vendor Wristbands per vehicle will be issued but such Vendor Wristbands may only be requested for individuals listed by name with my application that I hereby certify will be working on my behalf in my spots; and (E) that if my application has been received and paid for by May 1, 2018; I understand that a Vending Package will be mailed to me on or about May 25, 2018; and (F) that it is my personal responsibility to retain and distribute these Vending Package materials to all individuals associated with my Vending Application; and (G) that if I cancel after May 1, 2018, or do not arrive by 8AM on Friday, June 15, 2018 (except for timely notice of late arrival), my space for 2018 may be assigned to another vendor, and that I am not entitled to a refund for the 2018 space but will be given first right of refusal for the space for 2019.

**ENFORCEMENT:** I understand if I do not abide by the rules, management can eject the entrant and/or vehicle from the premises. Ejection may cause loss of any refundable fees and also denial of any future membership with the National AMCA. I agree to comply peacefully with all the above stated expectations and with verbal clarification of the same AMCA Chapters personnel.
