

**IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR
RELEASING VEHICLES AND PROPERTY**

ANY ALTERED, MUTILATED, EXPIRED, OR
QUESTIONABLE ID CAN NOT BE ACCEPTED

**PHOTO IDENTIFICATION TO RELEASE
VEHICLE/PROPERTY**

Oklahoma DPS Rules require a photo ID to release a vehicle (or property) to a vehicle owner. The photo ID must be issued by a Federal, State, County, or City government or Agency. We must have a copy to be able to release a vehicle or property per DPS Rules. See the DPS Administrative rules for other conditions in addition to the photo ID requirement. A DUI receipt may be used if an officer signed that the driver's license was surrendered during a DUI arrest/test when the driver/owner is immediately released from jail. DUI receipt is not a permanent ID replacement and an Oklahoma ID should be issued after a few days.

MEXICAN/HISPANIC PHOTO IDs

We will no longer be able to accept IDs purchased at retail outlets. All photo IDs must be issued by a government entity in the United States, Canada, or Mexico. The photo ID may be issued by a government entity with a photo ID. A Mexican driver's license may be accepted if it meets the standards of an Oklahoma License (bar code, dual photo, hologram, and etc. Reciprocal agreement with Mexico). We can accept valid unexpired passports or US immigration cards ("Green Card") to prove identity. Proper identification must be presented to be able to release property OR the vehicle. Only a valid driver's license may be used to drive the vehicle from the storage facility.
