About the WLD

In 1981, a group of women attorneys were “summoned” to discuss the challenges to advancement in the legal profession by women of color in the Philadelphia area. These luminaries knew that they had a role in improving the business and legal community. They knew diversity and inclusion were better for all. They had to figure out how to get a seat at the table.

From that discussion, the National Bar Association Women Lawyers Division, Philadelphia Chapter (WLD) was born. For more than 35 years the WLD has developed CLE programs to improve knowledge and skills, created networking opportunities to help make connections and offered mentoring programs to help members meet and overcome challenges.

Through the leadership of legendary women, today, the WLD’s membership includes more than 300 attorneys and judges in the tristate area.

About the Foundation

The Foundation of the National Bar Association, Women Lawyers Division (Philadelphia Chapter) was established by the Philadelphia Chapter of WLD to award scholarships to deserving law students while honoring the late Justice Juanita Kidd Stout and Sadie T.M. Alexander, Esquire, two African American women of many “firsts.” Justice Juanita Kidd Stout was the first African American woman to be elected to the Philadelphia Court of Common Pleas and the first in the United States to serve on a state Supreme Court. Sadie T.M. Alexander was the first African American woman to graduate from the University of Pennsylvania School of Law and the first African American woman to be admitted to the Pennsylvania Bar. Proceeds from the event benefit the organization’s scholarship fund.
