One of my favorite promises from the Word of God is found in Jeremiah 32:40-41.

JEREMIAH 32:40-41

- 41 Yea, I will rejoice over them to do them good, and I will plant them in this land assuredly with my whole heart and with my whole soul.

What a description of God's design for us! He wants to "do us good." This is what makes the Father rejoice! Why? It is because He desires to bless us, to help us, and to provide for us. The Lord even receives glory as we walk in His abundant blessing. He explains this in Jeremiah 33.

JEREMIAH 33:9
