Mechanical Bull Riders LLC was established in 2019 to provide an opportunity for those willing and able to challenge themselves on mechanical bulls in an endurance riding competition and compete for the Mechanical Bull Riders World Championship. Our foundation has four principles: 1) The event connects America, 2) It's an open event, 3) All Contestants compete together, and 4) It's a win for everyone involved. OUR MISSION is to provide a pathway to empowerment and the inspiration to achieve.

In 1980 the iconic hit movie Urban Cowboy made mechanical bull riding popular. On August 24, 2019 Mechanical Bull Riders LLC gave it a purpose with the Mechanical Bull Riders World Championship at the Harvester Restaurant & Lounge in Spangle, Washington just south of Spokane. After much research we concluded that gender did not determine riding ability or the ability to perform at a high level of endurance, and riders could come from almost anywhere and be competitive. So we decided the competition would be A ONE HAND 30 Second ENDURANCE RIDING EVENT with three Go-Rounds and open to men and women riders 18 years and older competing together. To date women have won 4 of 7 Mechanical Bull Rider World Championships.

The success of Mechanical Bull Riders has spawned an additional event. The Basketball Shooters 5-ARC World Championship consists of taking 3 shots at designated locations behind each of 5 arcs. There are two Go-Rounds in this event. In one Go-Round the familiar circular rim is used and the other Go-Round has a square rim.

Our Events have been held in concert and festival settings, as a standalone event, in saloon and restaurant venues, and at fairs. All Contestants must sign a "Release, Waiver And Hold Harmless Agreement". The Mechanical Bull Riders World Championship requires riders to be at least 18 years of age. The Basketball Shooters World championship has no age requirement but must contain a Parent, Legal Guardian or Responsible Person signature if the contestant is under 18 years of age.
