

5-ARC BASKETBALL SHOOTING RULES

- 1) The court is a basketball half court with five shooting distances representing shots taken behind 5 arcs. For the **Circular Rim Court** Go-Round a contestant will take three shots at designated locations behind the 1 point (13ft. 9in.) arc location, then three shots behind the 2 point (18ft.), 3 point (22ft.), 4 point (26ft.), and 5 point (30ft.) arc locations. Points are based on which arc location the ball is shot behind. Examples: if a shot is made behind the 1 point arc location it counts as 1 point, if a shot is made behind the 4 point arc location it counts as 4 points, if all three shots are made behind the 3 point arc locations then 9 points are awarded. For the **Square Rim Court** Go-Round the scoring is the same as the Circular Rim Court Go-Round. There is a possible 45 points for each Go-Round. A 10 point bonus will be awarded to a Contestant earning 90 points for a possible event total of 100 points.
- 2) Entries (Males and Females together, No Age Requirement) are limited. On Event Day Contestants must check in 1 hour before the Start Time, read and sign the "Release, Waiver And Hold Harmless Agreement" (If under 18 years of age Contestants must have a Parent, Legal Guardian or Responsible Person sign the "Release, Waiver, And Hold Harmless Agreement"), pay the \$15 Entry Fee, obtain their Contestant number, be ready when their name is called, and be available for media and photos.
- 3) Alcohol, drugs or any impairing substances are not allowed for Contestants and Contestants must be physically and mentally capable of participating.
- 4) All involved will conduct themselves in an exemplary, sportsmanlike manner. Personal and/or political expressions, viewpoints, etc. are not allowed.
- 5) Basketballs will be available for the event but not for warming up or practice. Contestants should bring their own for that purpose, and may use their own in the event.
- 6) Basketball shooters should make continual progress to complete the event, and be available to rebound for the contestant before and after them.
- 7) Any complaints etc. must be submitted in writing and will be addressed as time permits.
- 8) A tie for the Championship will result in a shoot-off. Other placing ties will have multi- awards
- 9) Court Officials will interpret rules and regulate the event.
