

Oasis Year-Long Leaders Bios



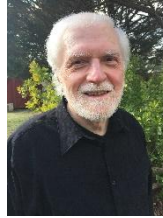

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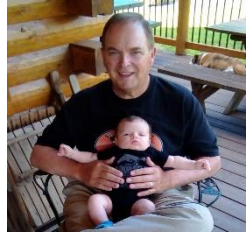
Dale Selover (CL), is a Child of God. While serving as a parish pastor, Dale became profoundly aware of her hunger for a deeper relationship with God. She
