What Can You Expect?

DYDM is a year-long training program consisting of two overnight retreats and six monthly sessions for practicing spiritual directors.

Each month includes:

- A seminar presentation by a guest spiritual direction leader on a theme that is vital to the presenter.
- The experience of a variety of spiritual direction styles as each month's guest directs another in a real play.
- Inter-active reflection and dialogue with staff on various themes
- Engagement with themes through seminars and guided retreat times.
- Peer sharing, mutual support, and the experience of contemplative community
- Use of verbatim and response questions to enhance growth in discernment
- Sharpening skills through supervision by staff and peers
- Celebrating gifts and growth in self-awareness and self-understandings
- Developing the art of prayerful self-supervision

Tuition

TUITION: \$2,695, plus an Application Fee of \$200 (non-refundable, not part of tuition). The balance of tuition may be paid in full at any time.

- Graduates of DYDM are welcome to participate again at 25% off of the full tuition.
- The morning seminar presentation during each monthly gathering (not retreat days) is open to trained spiritual directors not enrolled in DYDM, from 10 am - 1 pm (please bring a bagged lunch). The cost for each of these sessions is \$80 and can be paid directly through our Oasis Ministries website store, by calling our office to register/pay by phone at 717-737-8222, or by mailing a check to our office at: 419 Deerfield Road, Camp Hill, PA 17011. Please make checks payable to Oasis Ministries and write which session you would like to attend in the memo section. Space is limited for our monthly meetings, so be sure to register
 - ➤ If the application is received by May 31, 2018, the participant will receive a discount of \$100 from their tuition.
 - ► If the application is received after August 31, 2018, \$75 will be added to their tuition fee.

Payments by check or credit card (MasterCard, Visa and Discover) are welcome. If paying via installments we anticipate the first payment to be \$350 (plus \$75 if application was received after August 31, 2018, minus \$100 if application was received prior to May 31, 2018). The first payment is due upon acceptance into the program (by September) and payments of \$335 monthly October- April.

Tuition remains the same regardless of the number of sessions attended. Oasis rarely cancels due to weather. If a regular program is cancelled due to weather an online meeting may be possible and any missed content will be made available to participants. No refunds for snow days or for session a participant needs to miss.

Participants of the Deepening Year must:

- Be graduates of either Oasis' Spiritual Direction for Spiritual Guides (SDSG) program, or another equivalent program
- Be practicing spiritual directors
- Be meeting regularly with a spiritual director themselves
- Complete the DYDM application. Participants who are graduates of the Oasis Ministries SDSG or DYDM program are still asked to complete the DYDM Application.
- Provide two letters of recommendation (if not a graduate of Oasis programming)
