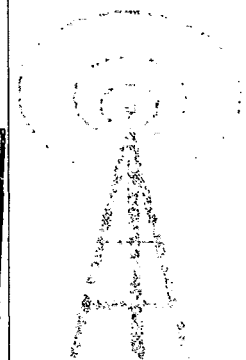

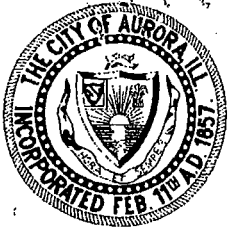

WEATHER : 80* SUNNY

On 08/11/04 at approx 1500 hrs, I was contacted by Lt. Robertson and Sgt. Rowley. I was requested to report to the front of 1200 E. Indian Trail which is the Aurora Police Department's main parking lot reference a suspicious vehicle.

I arrived on scene and spoke with LT. Robertson. LT. Robertson and Sgt Rowley advised they believed the vehicle may contain drugs. (See their follow ups).

I then spoke with the owner of the vehicle, arrestee Pasteris. Pasteris advised that she was at a 'DRAKE' concert the previous night, and her vehicle most likely had a strong odor of cannabis due to other people in the area smoking it. I advised Pasteris that I was going to walk my dog around the outside of her unoccupied vehicle. Pasteris gave consent to walk my dog on the out of her vehicle.

I then started 1 vehicle to the West of her vehicle. I deployed K9 Akroy on the exterior of the vehicle with no alert, then moved on to the exterior of Pasteris's vehicle. K9 Akoy then alerted to the presence of a narcotic odor at the rear passenger side door seam. I then moved K9 Akroy over another vehicle parked just East of Pasteris's vehicle, and K9 Akroy did not alert to that vehicle.

I then advised Pasteris that K9 Akroy only alerted to the presence of a narcotic odor on her vehicle. Pasteris then handed me the keys to her vehicle and gave me consent to search it.

Lt. Robertson and I then searched the vehicle. I located a "blunt" (cigar filled with cannabis) in the storage unit behind the center controls in the front dashboard.

Lt. Robertson then located more cannabis in the glove box of the vehicle.

Pasteris denied ownership of the cannabis but advised that she forgot to check her vehicle for any drugs before she left.

Pasteris was transported to APD Booking and was given a court date of 09/24/14 at 0900hrs in the Aurora Branch Court. Her vehicle was released at the scene to Morton.

The cannabis field tested positive for the presence cannabis and weighed a total of 1.38gms using the digital scale located in APD Evidence.

The cannabis was placed into evidence locker #23 with all necessary evidence forms.
