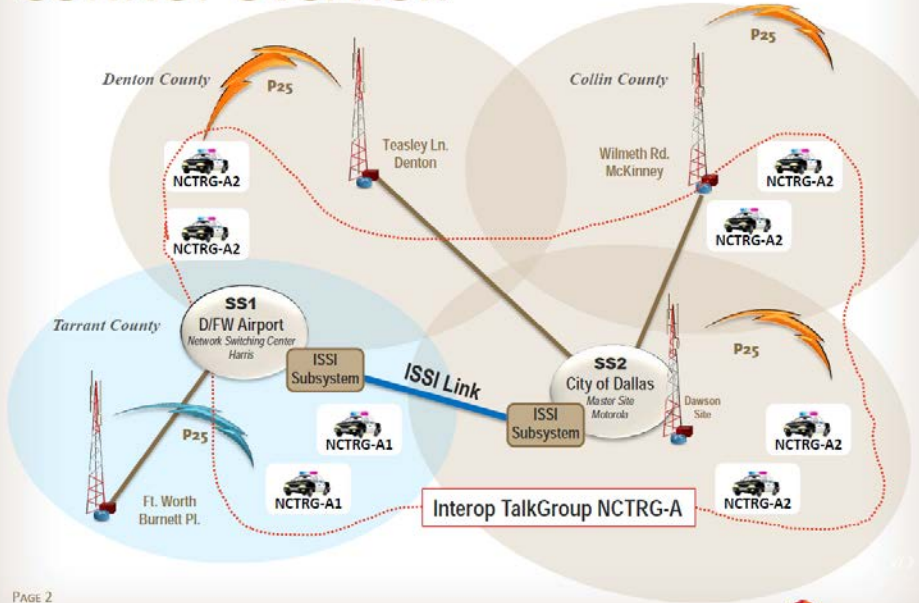

What does 2015 Bring?

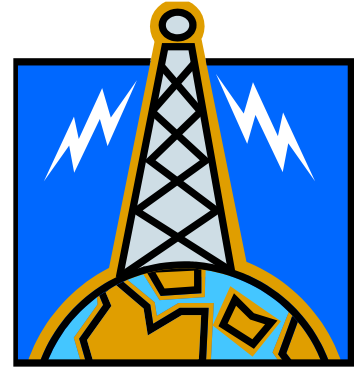
CONNECT Overview

USER CHANGES:

- For the user, you will be able to roam between all 4 counties on the regional talkgroups without user intervention and the radio will pick the best site. This should improve implementation and Interoperability.

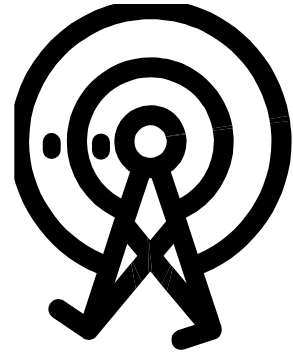


- Radio Programming and Using the CONNCT system
 - All radios that will utilize the CONNCT system will require reprogramming.
 - Current Tarrant County control channels will be need to be moved to the Motorola sub-System.
 - Our primary connections will be the current NCTRG-A2, B2, C2 and D2.
 - NCTRG-A1, B1, C1 and D1 will move to wherever the Harris system is located.
 - That location has not been determined.
 - Fort Worth plans to reprogram our First Responders between mid-October and mid-January.



We have programming information available for control channels from all of the connected systems.

This information should be programmed into radios that may need to take advantage of the Interop Zones (LAW, FIRE, EMS, etc.) so you can communicate in any area for incidents or events.
