Re: Improving diplomatic relations with Japan

His Excellency Mr. Kim Jong-un,

Recently as you already know, the government of the People's Republic of China is working on improving its diplomatic relations with the government of Japan. I believe that this was an extremely smart move to make for the People's Republic of China, especially due to the fact that the People's Republic of China and Japan do not have a good procedural history as to engaging in non-hostile relations with one another. I am extremely happy to see that two countries, such as the People's Republic of China and Japan, are in the process of working together to improve their diplomatic relations that they have between one another. As part of this initiative, the government of the People's Republic of China is sending representatives to improve diplomatic relations with Japan by having its representatives enter into a Japan, and a South Korean Summit.<sup>1</sup> I also suspect that the government of the People's Republic of China will be sending its representatives to Japan as an effort as to improving diplomatic relations and I believe that the government of Japan will also be doing the same, for the same purpose, with regard as to the People's Republic of China.

I believe that would be beneficial for the international community, and for both parties, to follow in the same footsteps that the People's Republic of China is involved in as with them seeking to improve their diplomatic relations with the government of Japan. I believe that the government of the Democratic People's Republic of China needs to work to improve diplomatic relations with the government of Japan and I also believe that the government of Japan needs to work as to improving the diplomatic relations with the government of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea. I do not believe that it is good diplomacy for the international community to blame one country with respect as to diplomacy while not working to ensure that all parties that are involved in a conflict are entering into peace talks equally in which would lead to the establishment of a peaceful settlement occurring. No one country should be the sole responsible party behind the peace talks occurring because peace talks that occur should be the initiative of both countries working equally and at the same rate as to establishing or re-establishing diplomatic relations between one another.



Since it does appear as if the government of the People's Republic of China and the government of Japan may be sending representatives to each other's country for the purpose as to working on improving diplomatic relations between one another, I believe that the government of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and the government of Japan needs to also do so with regard as to one another. Specifically speaking, I believe that representatives of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea needs to make trips to Japan, or in some neutral country, for the purpose as to having peace talks occur between the government of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and Japan.
