His Excellency Mr. Kim Jong-un,

I would like to clarify a part of my September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 communication to you, as far as the situation in the Republic of the Union of Myanmar is concerned. I would like to re-clarify with you that the situation in the Republic of the Union of Myanmar is of extreme international concern and does need to be respectfully resolved in a way that is fair and that is just. Since the situation in the Republic of the Union of Myanmar is extremely important to the international community, due to atrocities that have occurred in that country against the Rohingya people, I believe that it would be beneficial to the international community as a whole and to the Rohingya people, if you helped ensure that the creation of some type of task force or commission occurred, in which would have the intent as to looking into asserted atrocities that have occurred against the Rohingya people, as well as working with the government of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar to help ensure that justice, accountability and that a fair and a just plan on action occurs as to addressing and improving the Rohingya crisis situation.

Lastly, as in regard to Europe, since it appears as if His Excellency Mr. Moon Jae-in, President of the Republic of Korea, has spoken about the peace talks between the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and the United States, on this trip to Europe, I believe that it would be better if you would meet face to face with leaders of the European Union<sup>1</sup> and with the leaders of governments of countries that are in the European Continent, to discuss all of the security concerns that the government of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea has against any governments that are with countries in Europe and the security concerns that governments of countries that are in Europe have against the government of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea. Having such a peace talk summit will help ensure that peace is possible and this will also help ensure that any misunderstandings will be resolved. I am confident that such a peace talk summit would be fruitful, that it would be of benefit to the international community as a whole, and that such a peace talk summit meeting would help ensure that peace prevails. But as I again believe that in order for the future peace talk summit to be fruitful, the security concerns that all have against each other does need to be addressed, in a respectful, and in a way that is fair and just without politics. Politics as you may already know has an awful procedural
