## **Dance Class Etiquette**

- 1. Be Prompt: Please arrive to class on time and ready to dance. If you must be late, enter the room quietly and join in quickly. If you are more than 15 minutes late, you may be asked to watch the remainder of class. Proper warm up is needed for every class to avoid injury.
- 2. Follow the Dress Code: Make sure you have the correct attire, shoes and hair is secured neatly off the face and neck. Dancer's are known for their poise and posture. This starts with what they wear to class.
- 3. Use the Restroom Before Class: Potty breaks can be very distracting in a younger class. Please help decrease this by having your child use the restroom before class begins.
- 4. No gum, food or drinks (except water) in the dance room.
- 5. Please no street shoes in the dance room: Dancers can store their bags, shoes and water bottles in the cubbies provided.
- 6. Let your body language show you are ready to learn: Dancers should stand tall with their hands at their sides. Bonus points for standing in one of the ballet positions.;)
- 7. Have **FUN**, try your best and take corrections with a smile: As dance teachers, we are here to provide dance education in a fun, safe, and healthy environment. We give our best in each class and expect the same in return.
- 8. Please keep talking in class to a minimum.

9. Respect your fellow students: Please do not correct other dancers, that is why we have teachers. :) Hands to ourselves, treat others as you would like to be treated and always use kind words.

10. Respect your teachers and thank them after class.
