 <p>Bluegill (2"-4") Used to maintain proper food chain. Mature at less than a year old. 4" long Great forage fish. Stocks nicely with bass.</p>	 <p>Yellow Perch (2"-3") Good reproduction, poor hatch survival. Restock every 3-4 yrs. Great for angling. Great eating fish. Needs a forage species present in pond.</p>
 <p>Hybrid Bluegill (2"-4") Reach 10"-11" long, 1-1 1/2 lbs Hard fighting pan fish, great for angling Should be restocked every few years.</p>	 <p>White Amur (8"-10") Eats vegetation, great weed control 8-10 per acre recommended . Do not overstock. Grows very large. Cannot reproduce, Sterile</p>
 <p>Redear Sunfish (2"-4") Reach 10"-12" long. 1-1 1/2lbs. Eats snails that can carry parasites. Slow reproduction, not good forage fish</p>	 <p>Japanese Koi (6"-8") Eats vegetation, duckweed, watermill Lives up to 50 years. Grows to 2-3 feet long typically.</p>
 <p>Fathead Minnow (2"-3") Works great for forage until bluegill spawn Typically only used for predator forage Great for bass, perch, catfish, crappie</p>	 <p>Natures Pond Conditioner Two in one product Bacteria eats muck on bottom of pond Dye blocks sunlight to bottom slowing vegetation /weed growth</p>
