NIV Genesis 16:1-2 "Now Sarai, Abram's wife, had borne him no children. But she had an Egyptian maid-servant named Hagar; 2 so she said to Abram, "The LORD has kept me from having children. Go, sleep with my maid-servant; perhaps I can build a family through her." Abram agreed to what Sarai said."
