## Living Supernaturally

### Week 8

We can experience Supernatural Living when we \_\_\_\_\_ to Jesus Christ.

**Text: Gal 5:22** “22 But when the Holy Spirit controls our lives, he will produce this kind of fruit in us: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness ...

**Definition of Faithfulness:** being someone in whom complete \_\_\_\_\_ can be placed.

Faithfulness builds \_\_\_\_\_ and community.

There are 3 Ways in which confidence is placed:

**One. God places confidence in us.**

**NLT 1 Samuel 16:13** So as David stood there among his brothers, Samuel took the olive oil he had brought and poured it on David's head. And the Spirit of the LORD came mightily upon him from that day on. Then Samuel returned to Ramah.

**Two. We place confidence in God.**

**1 Sam 17:32-37 (NLT)** <sup>32</sup> “Don't worry about this Philistine,” David told Saul. “I'll go fight him!” <sup>33</sup> “Don't be ridiculous!” Saul replied. “There's no way you can fight this Philistine and possibly win! You're only a boy, and he's been a man of war since his youth.” <sup>34</sup> But David persisted. “I have been taking care of my father's sheep and goats,” he said. “When a lion or a bear comes to steal a lamb from the flock, <sup>35</sup> I go after it with a club and rescue the lamb from its mouth. If the animal turns on me, I catch it by the jaw and club it to death. <sup>36</sup> I have done this to both lions and bears, and I'll do it to this pagan Philistine, too, for he has defied the armies of the living God! <sup>37</sup> The LORD who rescued me from the claws of the lion and the bear will rescue me from this Philistine!” Saul finally consented. “All right, go ahead,” he said. “And may the LORD be with you!”

**1 Sam 17:45-47 (NLT)** <sup>45</sup> David replied to the Philistine, “You come to me with sword, spear, and javelin, but I come to you in the name of the LORD of Heaven's Armies—the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. <sup>46</sup> Today the LORD will conquer you, and I will kill you and cut off your head. And then I will

give the dead bodies of your men to the birds and wild animals, and the whole world will know that there is a God in Israel! <sup>47</sup> And everyone assembled here will know that the LORD rescues his people, but not with sword and spear. This is the LORD's battle, and he will give you to us!”

Am I living a God-sized dream that \_\_\_\_\_ on God's faithfulness to me?

**Three. We place confidence in each other.**

**1 Sam 18:1-5 (NLT)** <sup>1</sup> After David had finished talking with Saul, he met Jonathan, the king's son. There was an immediate bond of love between them, and they became the best of friends. <sup>2</sup> From that day on Saul kept David with him and wouldn't let him return home. <sup>3</sup> And Jonathan made a solemn pact with David, because he loved him as he loved himself. <sup>4</sup> Jonathan sealed the pact by taking off his robe and giving it to David, together with his tunic, sword, bow, and belt. <sup>5</sup> Whatever Saul asked David to do, David did it successfully. So Saul made him a commander over the men of war, an appointment that was welcomed by the people and Saul's officers alike.
