You are the salt of the earth
Jesus wants us to know that He's or us!

For all to see
Jesus wants us being salt and light to those already to Him as well as those from Him.
There's a lot riding on us being who Jesus seems to think we can be!!
<sup>20</sup> "But I warn you—unless your righteousness is better than the righteousness of the teachers of religious law and the Pharisees, you will never enter the Kingdom of Heaven!
How do you feel about Jesus thinking so highly of you? Does it intimidate you? Or does it inspire you and fire you up?!!
