Prov 3:1-20 (NLT) My child, never forget the things I have taught you. Store my commands in your heart.² If you do this, you will live many years, and your life will be satisfying. **God wants us living a** ______ **life.**

³ Never let loyalty and kindness leave you! Tie them around your neck as a reminder. Write them deep within your heart.⁴ Then you will find favor with both God and people, and you will earn a good reputation.

Favor: excessive kindness or unfair _____; preferential treatment.

⁵ Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding.

⁶ Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.

The quality of our life-journey is contingent upon "seeking God's will in all we do" and not relying only on what we know or think we know.

⁷ Don't be impressed with your own wisdom.

Instead, fear the LORD and turn away from evil.⁸ Then you will have healing for your body and strength for your bones. The most important healing we need *is for our pride*.

⁹ Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce.¹⁰ Then he will fill your barns with grain, and your vats will overflow with good wine.

Honor the Lord: recognize that He is the One *that gives us* everything.

¹¹ My child, don't reject the LORD's discipline, and don't be upset when he corrects you.¹² For the LORD corrects those he loves, just as a father corrects a child in whom he delights.
