As we have become fully aware, life as we know it has changed significantly in the last few weeks. On Wednesday of this week, I participated in an online meeting with the Superintendent and many others to discuss our handling of the many limitations we now face. Supt. Lumston has asked us to cancel our Sunday services for the next two Sundays. He will reevaluate the situation again soon and make further recommendations. When the gathering limit is increased back to 50 people, we will resume our regular Sunday schedule.

Here is what we will be doing at Canton Wesleyan until the gathering limit is increased... first, we will still hold our 9:30 am prayer meeting. While it will be limited to the first 10 people, I believe this is an essential ministry for us to continue.

Secondly, the Change Team will continue to meet at 10:00 am. We have many matters to work thru given the emergency situation we're facing.

Third, on Sunday, March 29, we will begin producing a sermon via CD, DVD, livestreaming thru Facebook, or on our website as we currently do (although there will be a video option, not just audio). I will be calling everyone to discuss this in more detail. In this call I will also discuss your preferences regarding your tithes and offerings.

For those that choose to watch the sermon via Facebook Live, that will be happening at 11:00 am on Sunday, March 29th.

Although this virus emergency severely limits our contact with each other, we will do all we can to remain connected and supportive to each other in ways that protect our health. I am once again reminded of God's promise to us in Romans 8:28 that He will make good things come out of bad things. Even though this is early in what might be months of restrictions, I already have a sense that God is leading us to make changes that will move our ministry forward.
