



# Cliff Greer

**Varsity Defensive Line Coach**

Coach Greer is beginning his fifteenth year on the Naples football staff, his seventh as co-defensive coordinator, and his eleventh season as coach of the varsity defensive line and college recruiting coordinator. Over the past eleven seasons, he has coached multiple defensive players of the year as well as all-area and all-state defensive linemen. Many of his players have continued their football careers at numerous colleges and universities around the country. Coach Greer's defensive lines have been an essential part of the program's last four regional titles and seven district titles, respectively. During that time three of his defensive linemen led the state of Florida in sacks at their positions. In 2021 his defense set records for least points allowed in a season (45), most shutouts (6) and consecutive shutouts (4). In 2020 his defense set a new school record only allowing .39 rushing yards

per carry. In 2018, his front four were a part of a dominant defensive unit that led the state in fewest points allowed in a season (86), which is 3rd in school history.

Born and raised in Akron, OH, he was a three-year starter and varsity letterman, playing guard and outside linebacker for Firestone High School. He graduated from his alma mater in 2003 with honors and a full academic scholarship to The Ohio State University. Coach Greer came to Naples sixteen years ago after graduating from The Ohio State University in 2007 with a B.S. in Construction Management, Cum Laude. Coach Greer currently works in the private sector as a project manager for a local private construction firm. He is truly blessed and thankful for Kami, a wonderful wife and mother to their children, and appreciates all her love and support. The Greer's have two sons CJ (11 years) and Kendrick (10 years) and one daughter Kennedy (5 years).
