

Exploring our Call: The Action Plan

We have since had a second leadership meeting, heavily focused around following through with the vision day's finding about how MFC connects with God, People and the Community. An update is provided below:

Connecting with God:

We are making sure this is in a framework that is easy to use and ensures everyone who wants to know are kept up to speed with urgent on-the-fly prayer requests and reminded of important matters to keep in their daily prayers.

We plan to do this in two key ways;

Firstly, through a regular set of prayer points in this Newsletter, on the Website and perhaps even on Facebook. There is a section further down in this newsletter which is set aside for this and is asking for prayer points to be added.

Secondly, we will be making sure that the details for the MFC prayer chain is clearly noted in the next fortnights edition of the newsletter and passed on to everyone at MFC.

Connecting with People (Fellowship):

Researching prayer partners/triplets further, we found that these are much more successful when the pair/triplets are formed from people within the same small group.

As a result, we've looked at the data collected from the polarity questions and found that a massive 50% of MFC members are not in a small group.

Based on this, we have shifted focus ever so slightly, angled towards breathing life into small groups at MFC first, equipping leaders within these groups and working through faith community wide teaching together, before venturing into prayer partners or triplets.

We also hope that by focusing on small groups, it will open up alternative methods for some people to connect with the church body, even if they can't make a Sunday service.



Exploring our Call - Continued

Connecting with Community:

So far Matthew Leadbetter, Julie Miller, Chad Teschward and Natalie Teschward have been busy researching alternative examples of church within a café/catering/commercial setting and have begun to put together a few ideas to form a basic business plan/model. However, there is still some work to go before this is structured enough to present.

One such example that has been looked at with some detail is around the basis of Cup From Above and how that operates, the experience gained and how that could apply to us.

Thankfully, Adam from Cup From Above, alongside a few of his faithful crew, have graciously agreed to come provide some further insight into what they've been doing in the hope of providing MFC with a taste of what could be expected.

Lastly, this missional idea was born from the members of MFC, and therefore make sure that if you have any ideas or suggestions, please catch up with Matt, Julie, Chad and Nat to share you mind!

Update from the Leadership Team:

Streamlining Rosters

We are going to re-evaluate the Worship and Dinner roster formats over the coming weeks with the intent to streamline them. We want to save time and energy for MFC members where we can, whilst keeping the outcome and important bits that we need.

We hope this will take pressure off MFC members, so we can all focus more on our missional callings and less on continued routine that isn't adding value.

Furthermore, now that we're starting to regularly see children attending worship, which is amazing, we want to start a Creche set-up and roster to help the families know worship time as a peaceful time.

Supporting Young Leaders:

We have been given the opportunity to sponsor some 1st Moreton Bay Boys to this year's Leadership retreat. As an amazing missional arm of MFC, the Girls and Boys brigade are a wonderful venture to support and as such the Leadership team have agreed to put forwards some funds to help make sure those boys who can't quite afford it can take this opportunity.




Looking for a New Home!
