Dear Dayspring Emmaus Community,

Welcome 2017. Seems like each year just goes by quicker and quicker. The old saying "there is not enough time in the day" becomes "there is not enough time in the year." In reflecting on the past year, the number of new pilgrims that became a part of our community was 149. God is amazing and His plans are always right. Scripture that comes to mind is Jeremiah 29:11-14, "For I know the plans I have for you declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."<sup>12</sup> Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. <sup>13</sup>You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart. <sup>14</sup>I will be found by you," declares the LORD, "and will bring you back from captivity. 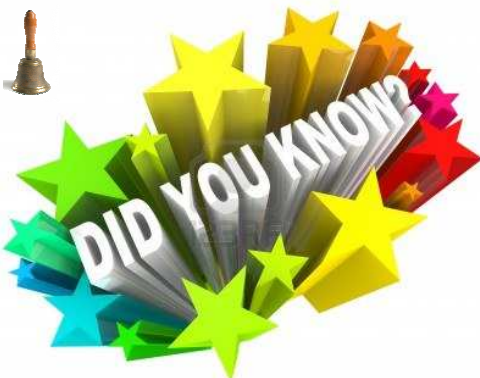

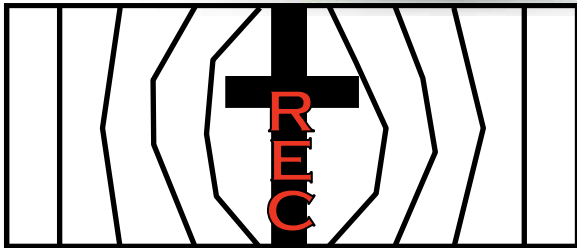

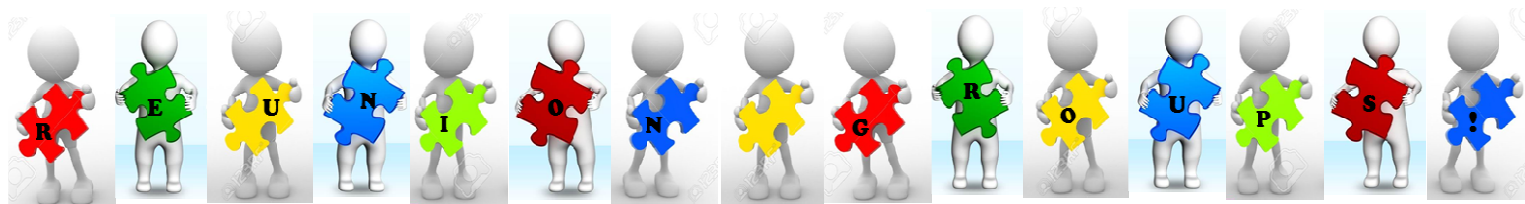

**What is a Reunion Group?** The Emmaus group reunion is a small accountability group of two to 12 persons who have usually participated in the three-day Walk to Emmaus and who want to continue their pursuit of a life lived wholly in the grace of God. These small follow-up groups help pilgrims translate the message conveyed on the Walk to Emmaus weekend into a daily walk with Christ. With the regular support of a few faithful friends, the gift of God's love in Jesus Christ becomes a lifestyle of Christian discipleship through the threefold discipline of piety, study, and action. Group reunions meet at regular times, usually weekly for an hour. The meeting consists of persons' sharing the stories of their walk with Christ during the past week. Members listen to one another, celebrate the grace of God in each person's life, and reinforce each one's core commitment to living in union with Christ in all facets of daily life. Members express that reinforcement through gentle accountability, encouragement, and support of one's stated discipline and plans. *Excerpted from The Group Reunion by Stephen D. Bryant. 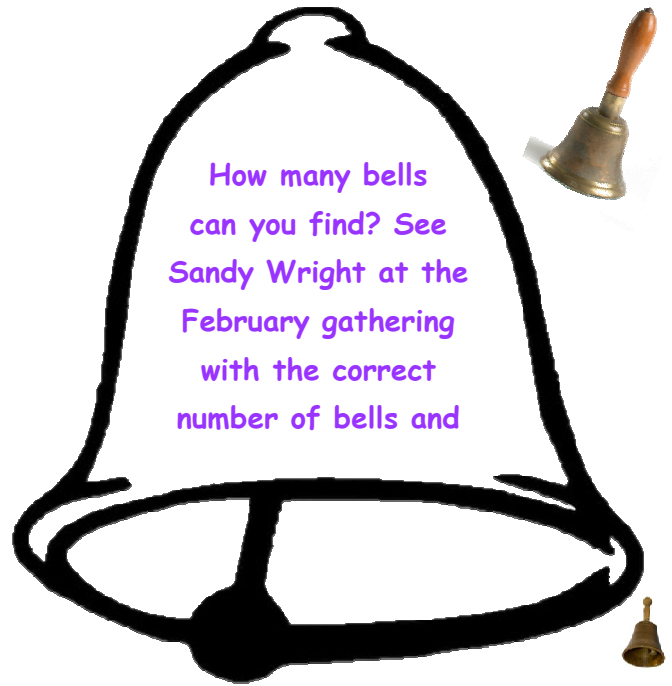
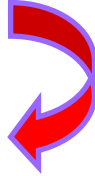
