In order to sponsor a pilgrim you will need to attend a sponsorship training session. A session is approximately 30 minutes. Even if you have sponsored pilgrims on previous walks, this training is required. You need only complete the training once in order to sponsor pilgrims in the future. This training program will be presented by the DaySpring Emmaus Community Board members at various venues throughout the community over the next several months and at all future follow-ups. If there are any reunion groups or church groups that would like to host the sponsorship training, contact Sarah Lentz (Sarah.lentz@adp.com) to schedule training. Check the Website or Facebook for dates of upcoming training.

Questions you may ask yourself when deciding to sponsor:

Whom should I sponsor on a Walk? Since the stated purpose of Emmaus is to bring together those who already are Christians and fortify them for leadership roles in the church, you should sponsor people who are members of a church (any denomination) *and attend regularly*.

What mistakes should I avoid? The Walk is only one way through which the Lord meets people at different states. Communicate that God touches each person in different ways, so don't even hint to your pilgrim that he or she will have a dramatic change after the 72 hours.

Think back to your own Walk. **What do you wish someone had done for you or told you?** Then do that for your pilgrim.

Dayspring Emmaus Walks 136 and 137 are fast approaching. Don't let a little thing like Sponsorship Training get in the way of sponsoring the pilgrim God has selected just for you! If you are in need of training prior to the upcoming walks, please reach out to Sarah Lentz at 502-445-6250. We can schedule a time and place that suits your needs and ensure no pilgrim is left behind!

Commit your pilgrim to the Lord, and trust God's team to follow His lead.

What is a Reunion Group? The Emmaus group reunion is a small accountability group of two to 12 persons who have usually participated in the three-day Walk to Emmaus and who want to continue their pursuit of a life lived wholly in the grace of God. These small follow-up groups help pilgrims translate the message conveyed on the Walk to Emmaus weekend into a daily walk with Christ. With the regular support of a few faithful friends, the gift of God's love in Jesus Christ becomes a lifestyle of Christian discipleship through the threefold discipline of piety, study, and action. Group reunions meet at regular times, usually weekly for an hour. The meeting consists of persons' sharing the stories of their walk with Christ during the past week. Members listen to one another, celebrate the grace of God in each person's life, and reinforce each one's core commitment to living in union with Christ in all facets of daily life. Members express that reinforcement through gentle accountability, encouragement, and support of one's stated discipline and plans. Excerpted from The Group Reunion by Stephen D. Bryant.
