PARK ENTRANCE FEES AT O'BANNON WOODS



Become A Sponsor

Did you know that in order to sponsor someone on the Emmaus Walk you must have attended sponsorship training? This 30 minute training will give you the basics of what you need to know. Trainings are held at various locations by a team of community trainers as well as after each gathering. Questions you may ask yourself when deciding to sponsor:

Whom should I sponsor on a Walk? Since the stated purpose of Emmaus is to bring together those who already are Christians and fortify them for leadership roles in the church, you should sponsor people who are members of a church (any denomination) and attend regularly.

What mistakes should I avoid? The Walk is only one way through which the Lord meets people at different states. Communicate that God touches each person in different ways, so don't even hint to your pilgrim that he or she will have a dramatic change after the 72 hours.

Think back to your own Walk. What do you wish someone had done for you or told you? Then do that for your pilgrim.

Commit your pilgrim to the Lord, and trust God's team to follow His lead.

What is a Reunion Group? The Emmaus group reunion is a small accountability group of two to 12 persons who have usually participated in the three-day Walk to Emmaus and who want to continue their pursuit of a life lived wholly in the grace of God. These small follow-up groups help pilgrims translate the message conveyed on the Walk to Emmaus weekend into a daily walk with Christ. With the regular support of a few faithful friends, the gift of God's love in Jesus Christ becomes a lifestyle of Christian discipleship through the threefold discipline of piety, study, and action. Group reunions meet at regular times, usually weekly for an hour. The meeting consists of persons' sharing the stories of their walk with Christ during the past week. Members listen to one another, celebrate the grace of God in each person's life, and reinforce each one's core commitment to living in union with Christ in all facets of daily life. Members express that reinforcement through gentle accountability, encouragement, and support of one's stated discipline and plans. Excerpted from The Group Reunion by Stephen D. Bryant.
