Do you remember your original Emmaus Walk? Do you want to rekindle that fire that burned within you on your Walk to Emmaus? **Join a reunion group!**

The Emmaus group reunion is a small accountability group of two to 12 persons who have usually participated in the three-day Walk to Emmaus and who want to continue their pursuit of a life lived wholly in the grace of God. These small follow-up groups help pilgrims translate the message conveyed on the Walk to Emmaus weekend into a daily walk with Christ. With the regular support of a few faithful friends, the gift of God's love in Jesus Christ becomes a lifestyle of Christian discipleship through the threefold discipline of piety, study, and action. Group reunions meet at regular times, usually weekly for an hour.

O'BANNON WOODS PARK ENTRANCE FEE

When you come to O'Bannon Woods to drop off your Pilgrim, attend Send-off, serve a meal, or for Closing, you WILL have to pay the park entrance fee of \$7 per car. 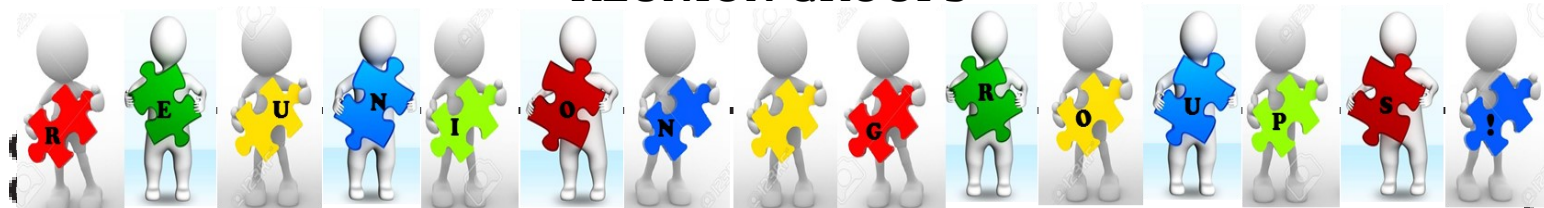
