Potable Water is defined as water that is safe to drink.

The water that is provided by Randy's Water Service is natural, (Artesian) spring water from a deep ground well.

We do not call it potable as doing so would require a large amount of investment and ongoing costs.

To term our water "Potable" we would have to:

- Obtain and maintain a license for potable water source
- Test the water on a regular basis (requires taking samples to a lab in Winnipeg)
- Carry liability insurance for drinking water supply

All of these items add costs that we would have to forward to the customer which would greatly increase the cost of water per load. At the same time, we would be putting the water into cisterns that we are not in control of and that may be contaminated so the water would have to be pre-treated.

We do not have access to pre-treated water so providing treated water would require further training, licensing, equipment and maintenance. Many of our customers prefer the spring water and do not wish for it to be treated.

We recommend that anyone who wishes to have potable water, to simply take a sample into one of the water testing labs in Winnipeg to have it tested for their own consumption.

If you prefer treated water, you are able to treat your own water in your tank with the addition of chlorine. Please research water treatment recommendations for treatment guidelines and instructions prior to adding any chemicals to your water.
