SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

Year A – 7th & 8th March, 2020

Today we learn the true goal of Lent, our own transformation into Christ.

In thinking about the Transfiguration, we are accustomed to concentrate on the glorious vision of Jesus' divinity shining through his humanity and we see it primarily as a proof of his divinity.

This image not only gives us a preview of the Resurrection, but to point out to us the ultimate effect that our own Lenten life above all our ongoing conversion to Jesus, is supposed to accomplish in us. We are to be transformed more and more into him, so that his features, his love, his compassion may transfigure us.

Not knowing what the future will contain for their beloved Master and for them, the Apostles filled with apprehension are ready to go with him. They strike out into the unknown, just as Abraham did.

One of life's most necessary lessons for us is to know how to let go and let God lead us.

Lord, we give thanks for these holy mysteries which bring to us here on earth a share in the life to come, through Christ our Lord.



24 HOURS FOR THE LORD

During Lent 2018, Pope Francis asked all of the Parishes in Rome to remain open for a 24 hour period during Lent. This practice has since been adopted by many Parishes around the world. This year we would like to hold it in our Parish. It will begin after morning Mass at 9.30 a.m. on and continue until 7.30 p.m. It will run over three days, commencing on Monday, 9th March and conclude on Wednesday, 11 March. The Programme will be as follows:

MONDAY 9TH MARCH - ST. MARY MACKILLOP CHURCH 9.30 A.M. MASS FOLLOWED BY EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT ALL DAY. BENEDICTION WILL CONCLUDE THE DAY AT 7.30 P.M.

TUESDAY 10TH MARCH - ST. MARY MACKILLOP CHURCH 9.30 A.M. MASS FOLLOWED BY EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT ALL DAY.

AT 7.30 P.M. THERE WILL BE SOLEMN EVENING PRAYER AND BENEDICTION. A LARGE NUMBER OF PRIESTS FROM ACROSS MELBOURNE, ALONG WITH BISHOP PETER ELLIOTT WILL JOIN US.

WEDNESDAY 11TH MARCH - ST. PAUL'S CHURCH 9.30 A.M. MASS FOLLOWED BY EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT ALL DAY. BENEDICTION WILL CONCLUDE THE DAY AT 7.30 P.M.

The first day will be dedicated to the Holy Spirit, the second to the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of Sorrows, and the third to Our Lord Jesus Christ, the Eternal High Priest. Please make time to attend as we pray for all the needs of our Parish and Church.

<u>LENT - 2020</u> <u>ASH WEDNESDAY & GOOD FRIDAY</u> ARE DAYS OF FASTING & ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT

On all other Fridays, the law of the practice of penance is fulfilled by performing any one of the following:

(A)**PRAYER** - for example, Mass attendance; Family Prayer; A visit to a Church or Chapel; Reading the Bible; Making the Stations of the Cross; Praying the Rosary; or in other ways.

(B)**SELF DENIAL** - for example, Not eating meat; Not eating sweets or dessert; Giving up entertainment to spend time with the family; Limiting food and drink so as to give to the poor of one's own country or elsewhere; or in other ways.

(C)**HELPING OTHERS** - example, Special attention to someone who is poor, sick, elderly, lonely, or over-burdened; or in other ways.

All who have completed their eighteenth year and have not yet begun their sixtieth year are bound to fast. All who have completed their fourteenth year are bound to abstain.

The season of Lent is a time of penance. During this season the faithful are encouraged to devote themselves in a special manner to prayer, to engage in works of piety and charity, and to deny themselves. Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This percent must be fulfilled between Ash Wednesday, 26th February and Trinity Sunday, 7th June 2020 unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time during the year.

All faithful are bound faithfully to confess their grave sins in the Sacrament of Penance at least once a year.
