

Lepers have been ostracized from society for centuries. Leprosy was a terrible disease that was infectious and caused people to have sever deformities. These people were often isolated from others so that the disease would not spread and because of their appearance, they often led very sad and lonely lives.

In the Gospel, it is the leper who approaches Jesus, defying all the rules and conventions of his society. Despite his exclusion and isolations, he has not lost hope.

Jesus is moved by pity not revulsion. Instead of sending the man away, he responds with immense compassion to the man's courage and faith. Jesus reaches out and touches him. The man is healed.

Who are the lepers in our lives today? Whom do we exclude from society and refuse to touch?

Living the word of God this week: Reach out and touch someone who needs a sign of acceptance or a gift of compassion.



<u>LENT - 2018</u>

ASH WEDNESDAY & GOOD FRIDAY ARE DAYS OF FASTING & ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT

On all other Fridays, the law of the practice of penance is fulfilled by performing any one of the following:

(A)**PRAYER** - for example, Mass attendance; Family Prayer; A visit to a Church or Chapel; Reading the Bible; Making the Stations of the Cross; Praying the Rosary; or in other ways.

(B)**SELF DENIAL** - for example, Not eating meat; Not eating sweets or dessert; Giving up entertainment to spend time with the family; Limiting food and drink so as to give to the poor of one's own country or elsewhere; or in other ways.

(C)**HELPING OTHERS** -example, Special attention to someone who is poor, sick, elderly, lonely, or over-burdened; or in other ways.

All who have completed their eighteenth year and have not yet begun their sixtieth year are bound to fast. All who have completed their fourteenth year are bound to abstain.

The season of Lent is a time of penance. During this season the faithful are encouraged to devote themselves in a special manner to prayer, to engage in works of piety and charity, and to deny themselves. Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This percent must be fulfilled between Ash Wednesday, 14th February and Trinity Sunday, 27th May 2018 unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time during the year.

All faithful are bound faithfully to confess their grave sins in the Sacrament of Penance at least once a year.
