Last Sunday's Gospel presented us with a firm short-range goal; the renewal of our baptismal promises at the Easter Vigil.

This week's Gospel gives us an even longer-range goal of resurrected glory.

On the way to the mountain of glory, other mountains less inviting must be climbed. Staying the hard path up these mountains is our only way to transfigured glory.

Lord, we give thanks for these holy mysteries which bring to us here on earth a share in the life to come, through Christ our Lord.








