In this week's Gospel, Jesus goes up to Jerusalem, whilst in the Temple, Jesus finds that business transactions were taking precedence over the worship of the people. The Gospel describes the 'angry' side of Jesus as he drives the trade and money changers out of the Temple and chastises them for their actions.

Additionally, Jesus provides an insight into what is to happen in a short time when he says...'Destroy this sanctuary and in three days I will raise it up...' It was these words that the disciples remembered at the time of His resurrection and they 'believed the Scripture and the words He had said...'
