Today is LAETARE Sunday. It is a Sunday of rejoicing because it recalls to us that we are GOD'S WORKS OF ART created by HIS GRACE, not by our personal efforts.

Let our tongues be silenced if we ever forget that God so loved the world, and each and every one of us – sinners and saints alike – so much, that HE gave up HIS ONLY SON, that all who believe in HIM, may have ETERNAL LIFE.

The exiles in the first reading tell us about their infidelity and their exile in Babylon. We can identify with them, when we turn away from God by our sinful alienation, in whatever form it assumes. SIN is a refusal to enter into the personal relationship that God extends to us all.

Our Lenten fasting, self-denial – all this does not cause or bring about God's grace and salvation. On the contrary, if we are doing all kinds of praise-worthy, holy deeds, it is because God's grace is active in us. In our good deeds, we simply respond to God's mercy and love for us.

Religious Freedoms/Protections

Currently there is a Federal Parliamentary Review on Religious Freedom following the amendment of the Marriage Act to change the definition to allow same sex couples to marry under this Federal law. Submissions have closed and some of the content in these submissions is quite alarming. We know from the 'Yes' campaign that this group was advocating the complete removal of religious freedoms from discrimination laws. Christian schools, churches and religious organisations would not be able to employ staff or enrol members or students that share their faith. The National Secular Lobby has gone even further in their submission arguing that indoctrination of children into religious faiths is a 'tragic consequence' of religious freedom protections in international law. The submission claims that "...it (religion) now represents intellectual child abuse to allow children to be taught Biblical myths..."

In Victoria, anti discrimination laws are currently being weaponised against faith based schools to force them to adopt radical transgender policies. Teaching the Gospel, maintaining a Christian home and providing a Christian education to the next generation are all fundamental principles that are genuinely under threat. Now that same sex marriage is law, it is clear that this is the next challenge facing the religious community. Please pray for our religious freedoms and be ready for the challenges that face our beautiful faith.

LETTING GO

One day while out walking, I was reflecting on my past, worrying about my future. After months of tests for a life-threatening illness, my doctor told me there was nothing more he could do and referred me to the oncology unit. I had left the surgery in a daze. How could this be happening? I searched for meaning but found none. Some ten years earlier I had struggled to accept another child into the family. I had thought that my child-bearing days were over and I was looking forward to doing some study. This child came into our lives and became the spring of light and life in our home. Having had these last ten years, my current anger was directed at God for threatening to take this away. After all, I was given a job to do (parenting) and I was not going to be able to finish it. What kind of God would give you a family to rear and then take you away before you had finished? It didn't make sense. I was extremely angry. As I walked, with my meditation and breathing I calmed down and cleared my mind of all thoughts of death. Out of one of those rare luminous silences came an answer. God spoke to me and said: 'They are my children too. Why do you think YOU know what is better for my children than I do? I love them unconditionally, and want only the best for them also. Trust me.' In this moment of truth I remembered that my God knows my needs as well as I do and I was left with a peaceful feeling. I knew deep down that no matter what lay ahead, things were going to be OK. I had no idea what that OK would mean in terms of living or dying, but I was able to accept whatever lay ahead knowing that God was there with me in all the stress and worry, walking with me, and this was enough to comfort me. My faith prepared me to meet the future,

Please note: there will be no 9.30am Mass held at St. Paul's Church on Wednesday 14th March.


