

## THE TRINITY EXPLAINED BY A PEASANT-COME SAINT



From a scene in the movie "The Reluctant Saint", about St. Guiseppe Cupertino, a scene where the Bishop, after listening to an interminably long theological discourse on the Trinity, wonders out to the stable and reveals to Giuseppe that he has always been troubled by the mystery of the Trinity. As a peasant, he could accept such things simply on faith, but now as a Bishop he feels troubled by the whole question; St. Thomas doesn't help. Giuseppe takes up a blanket and answers simply: "look, one blanket, one God", then folding it three times, explains "three folds in one blanket, like the Trinity." Not quite Aquinas, but very much in the spirit of certain parables taught by a carpenter's son.
